

Shipping to Northern Ireland:


1. Use **United Kingdom** country code as usual

1.1. for **Air Services:**

- enter postcode as normal
- select a service from the list

1.2. for **Road Services:**

- use **RD1** in postcode box for postcodes BT1 to BT17



Since Brexit, shipping to Northern Ireland requires additional Customs, Security & Safety Declarations, if either the Collection or Delivery addresses are businesses you are now required to enter an EORI number by default will initially only provide one line to entry the details of the “Duty Goods Description”, “HTS Code”, “Origin”, “Items”, “Item Value”.
